Examples	Service provider provides scheduled Speech & Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, School Social Work, or other service directly to the student. Record Maintenance	Service provider documents instructional dates, activities, and data on progress, progress reporting to parents	Service provider documents consultation dates and topics, data on progress, progress reporting to parents	Service provider documents monitoring dates and topics, data on progress
